

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL ROTATIONS & TRAVEL

Health requirements for rotations which exceed those required for entrance to Des Moines University will be provided at no cost in Student Health Services. Health requirements for international travel related to missions and other trips approved and sponsored by Global Health will be provided at no cost as well. Confirmation of the trip must be provided to Student Health Services by the Global Health Department. To make an appointment, call Student Health at 515-271-7883. Additional requirements may include, but are not limited to the following:

- Drug testing
- Labwork
- Hepatitis A vaccination
- Rabies vaccination
- Meningococcal vaccination
- Yellow fever vaccination
- Typhoid vaccination

Appointments for some of the above items must be scheduled at least one week ahead of time, as not all medications will be routinely stocked. Unstocked items will need to be ordered prior to administration.

Prescriptions for malaria prophylaxis may also be obtained by scheduling an appointment in Student Health.

The above services will only be provided at no cost if obtained at Des Moines University Clinic. Students will be financially responsible for services obtained elsewhere. Reimbursement will not be provided to students who obtain additional rotation requirements at other facilities.
